

Steps to accessing and taking the Emergency Services Test.

1. Go to <https://www.capnhq.gov>
2. Enter your CAP ID number and then your password.
3. Once you have accessed the **e-Services**. I recommend that you first open the CAP Regulation 60-3. Once you have this regulation open continue with the steps below:
4. On the right of the **e-Services** page go down the left column until you find CAP On-Line Exams. Click on the link and that will take you to:
